

## Serve on Team

For the four-day weekends, you could be on the Inside team or the Outside Support team.

“Listen, Listen,  
Love, Love” – the  
Kairos motto.

The **Inside Team** must be made up of the same gendered persons as the incarcerated participants. They go into the prison and take the Kairos experience to the inmates. The **Support Team** can be of mixed gender and works outside the prison to supply the support needed for the Weekend.

## Donate New Bibles

Bibles are needed for new believers who do not possess a Bible and desire one. Many Bible passages are read and referred to during the Weekend. Residents are encouraged to look them up later. Contributions to purchase Bibles for distribution are given to prison chaplains.

## Make Posters
